SPECIFICATIONS:**

1. All work and material described in the following Sections are included within the scope of this Subcontract:
 - Division 00 Procurement and Contracting Requirements – All Sections
 - Division 01 General Requirements – All Sections
 - Section 09 30 13 – Ceramic Tiling
 - Section 09 65 13 – Resilient Base and Accessories
 - Section 09 68 13 – Tile Carpeting

SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Furnish and install all porcelain wall tile (RE: A10.01 and Section 09 30 13), including but not limited to:
 - a. WT-1: Daltile Luminique Rectangle; glossy finish, 12x24 tile, Arctic White.
 - b. WT-2: Daltile Luminique Rectangle Fluted; glossy finish, 12x24 tile (fluted), Arctic White.
 - c. WT-3: Daltile Color Wheel Linear; glossy finish, 6x18 rectangle tile, Arctic White.
 - d. Grout.
 - e. Adhesive and mortar.
 - f. Trim as specified.
 - g. Edge strips.
 - h. Floor sealer.
 - i. Underlayment.
2. Furnish and install all resilient wall base, including but not limited to:
 - a. Tarkett 4” vinyl base.
 - b. Adhesive.
3. Furnish and install all carpet tile flooring, including but not limited to:
 - a. Shaw Contract Centered 18x36 carpet tile; 5T492 Spontaneous 90505.
 - b. Adhesive.
 - c. Moisture testing of slab prior to installation.
4. Furnish and install all walkoff carpet, including but not limited to:
 - a. Patcraft Walk Forward; Moving 1053; Saunter 00560.
 - b. Adhesive.
 - c. Moisture testing of slab prior to installation.
5. Minor floor prep as required.
6. Strict compliance with all general and specific notes shown on the construction drawings.
7. All layout required for this scope of work.
8. Coordination with third-party testing agency.
9. Field measuring for all items provided by this subcontractor.
10. All tools and equipment required to complete this subcontractor’s scope of work.
11. All scaffolding and/or lifts required to complete this subcontractor’s scope of work.
12. All hoisting and hoisting equipment required to complete this subcontractor’s scope of work.
13. Strict compliance with all OSHA guidelines.
14. Submittals as specified/required (product data, samples, installation instructions, shop drawings, engineered drawings, reports, certificates, sample warranties, etc.).



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15. Delivery and storage of material (furnish connex(es) as required).
16. Freight to jobsite.
17. Receiving and unloading of material at the jobsite.
18. Daily clean-up during this subcontractor's operations (dumpster provided by Clark).
19. Provide specified materials, model numbers and approved manufacturers only. Any deviations will be subject to removal and replacement, including any replacement of damaged items installed by others, at no additional cost.
20. Provide warranties and extended warranties as specified.
21. Provide attic stock as specified.
22. This Subcontractor will be required to provide detailed record documents (As-Builts) that document the following (including but not limited to): Architect's proposal request changes, RFI's, communication, Architect's supplemental instructions, field changes and other such approved changes.
23. One (1) year warranty for material and workmanship from the date of substantial completion.
24. Sales tax as required.
